# RESCUE HOMES

## PROJECT FACT SHEET

Without anyone to intervene, these precious children have no hope and are left alone struggling to survive. Poverty and hopelessness are robbing them of their very lives and any chance for a more promising future. The situation is urgent and lives are at stake every day. But the future does not have to continue to be bleak for children in Uganda. We can make a difference... we can save their lives. World Help is working strategically to intervene on behalf of these orphaned and abandoned children. We are committed to saving lives, restoring hope, and building futures.

The slums of Uganda are overrun with more than 11 million children desperate for help. Alone, these children have literally nothing and no hope for survival. They are left to fend for themselves in the dangerous, dirty streets of Kampala without anyone to care for their most basic needs. Thousands of children are abandoned or orphaned every single day—some are AIDS orphans, while others have been abandoned simply due to the severe poverty they were born into... causing their parents to leave because they were unable to care for their sons and daughters and had nowhere to turn.

Currently, two Rescue Homes have been constructed at our Baby Rescue Center, located near the slums of Kampala. These homes are already providing a safe and nurturing environment for 22 babies, providing them with the life-saving supplies they desperately need. With the ever-growing need to offer safety and care to many more children throughout Kampala, World Help is working diligently with our international partners in Uganda to build three additional Rescue Homes. These homes will allow our partners to take in additional babies, ultimately saving their lives and giving them hope for brighter futures.

## Phase I

Through the construction of the third home, we will be able to house 10 babies that will be cared for by a house mother in a loving and safe environment. These babies will be nursed back to health and given the love and attention they desperately need.

**The total cost for Phase I is \$25,000 and will include the construction and outfitting of the home.**



## Phase II

Once the fourth home is fully constructed, our partners will be able to house an additional 10 babies that have been orphaned or abandoned as well as house mothers that will care for these children's many needs. This home will have individual bedrooms as well as a kitchen and living area where the children can grow.



**For only \$35,000, we can make the plans for this fourth Rescue Home a reality. These costs will fund the construction and furnishing of the home.**



## Phase III

This fifth Rescue Home will have double the capacity—housing 20 babies in total. These babies will finally receive adequate care and love that will restore hope and help build better futures.

**For \$50,000, you can invest in saving the lives of 20 babies in Uganda. These costs will include the complete construction of the home as well as the outfitting.**

For each phase of these three additional homes, the funds will enable us to not only complete the construction of each home, but fund the furnishing and outfitting that will include some of the following:

- Baby cribs
- Mattresses and bedding (for both the babies and the house mothers)
- Mosquito nets
- Cupboards for storage
