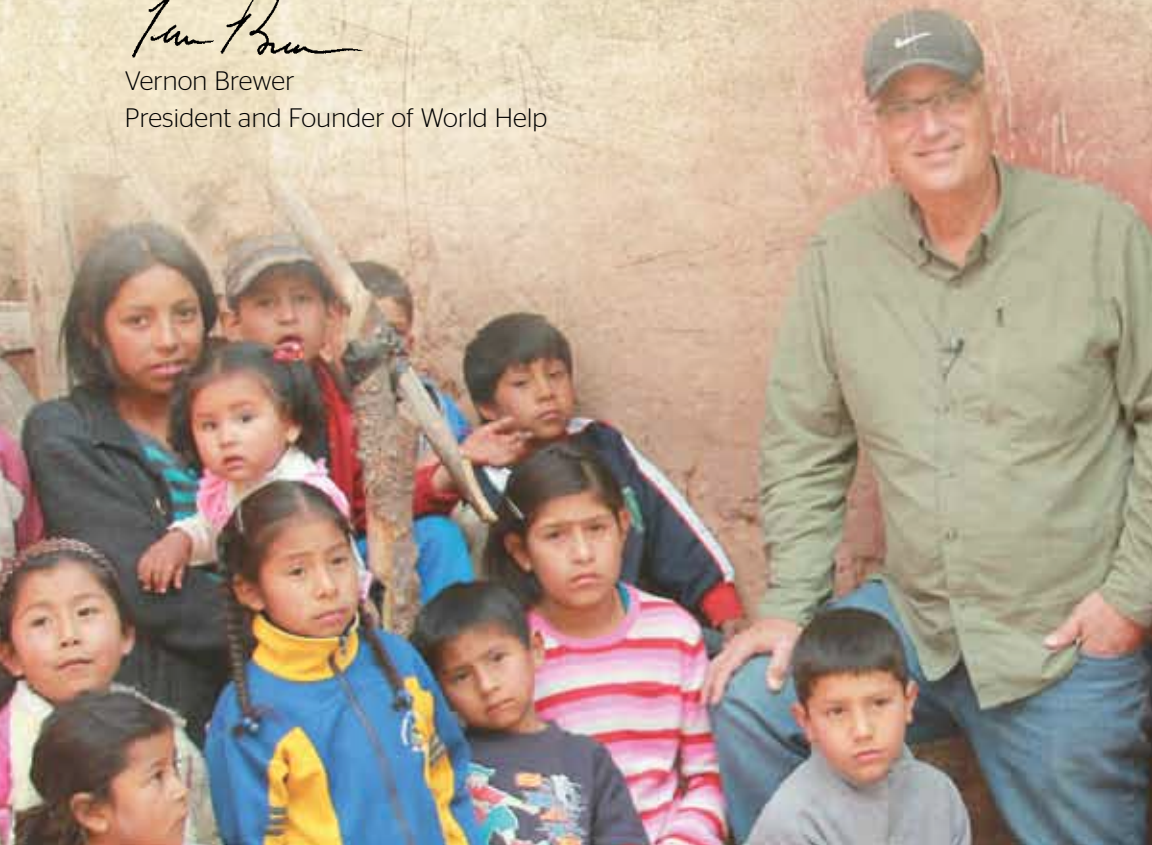
But we were created for so much more than just surviving. We have been given the promise of hope. And it's a promise that was meant to be shared.
