CHILDREN FACING HUNGER IN ZIMBABWE

Earlier this year, Cyclone Idai wiped out much of Zimbabwe's crops – a devastating blow for this country already facing severe food insecurity due to earlier droughts. It has been especially hard for children like 10-year-old Rita whose family depends on farming for their livelihood. *Please pray for Rita and other children in Zimbabwe suffering food shortages.*

SYRIAN CHILDREN IN REFUGEE CAMPS

Now in its eighth year, the Syrian civil war has displaced more than 5 million children from their homes. Most live in overcrowded refugee camps where there isn't enough food to go around. These children have already experienced unimaginable trauma, and now they are starving. *Pray for refugee children who don't know where their next meal is coming from.*

KIDS SUFFERING MALNUTRITION IN HAITI

One out of every 14 children in Haiti is expected to die of hunger-related issues before the age of 5. Malnourished mothers also struggle to produce milk for their young children, resulting in cases like Adassa who weighed just 10 pounds at 2 years old. *Please pray for children like Adassa ... children who are sick and starving and are still waiting for help.*

SUDANESE AND SOUTH SUDANESE CHILDREN

Sudan is in the middle of a full-scale revolution. At the same time, ongoing violence in South Sudan has flooded refugee camps in neighboring Uganda with children orphaned by war. World Help donors have been able to aid these children with food and through child sponsorship programs so they can attend a nearby school, but many more still need help. *Pray that God will protect children who have lost their parents to violence.*

CHILDREN WORLDWIDE WAITING FOR A SPONSOR

Countless children around the globe lack essentials like food, water, medicine, clean clothes, and educational opportunities – just to name a few.
