INDIA

Your investment in Gilgal Children's Home is one that will live on for generations. Because of you, children are able to earn an education, hear about God's Word, and receive the tools to build a better future.

Through your giving this year and the ongoing impact from your fundraiser last year, you have helped every child at Gilgal in one way or another. KELLY'S HOUSE

Your support of Kelly's House in Guatemala means that children with special needs have the medical attention and loving care they desperately require. Thank you for helping to improve the lives of kids like Juan Diego.

At age 10, Juan was diagnosed with muscular dystrophy and brought to Kelly's House. His family knew there he would be able to receive the best possible care.

Before Juan arrived at Kelly's House, he was confined to a bed. He couldn't do any of the things a normal little boy does like go outside, run, play with friends, or go to school.

But you helped equip Kelly's House to aid children like Juan, and he is now living a healthier and happier life. He receives regular physical therapy and nutritious meals. And he loves his newest gift: a motorized wheelchair that gives him the freedom to move around on his own and be more independent.

His health has improved so much that he now attends school and is making new friends. When asked what he would say to the people who have helped him, he responded, "Thank you for making my life better."

Thanks to your support of Kelly's House, children with special needs in Guatemala now have the chance for a better life.





GUATEMALA

Guatemala is one of the poorest countries in the world, but thanks to Kingdom Partners, numerous families there now have hope.

The people of Tasharte are especially grateful for all you have done to transform their village. You have invested in their physical health through clean water, healthy food, sanitary bathrooms, a pastor's home, school classrooms and repairs, and a playground. But most importantly, you have invested in their spiritual health by giving them a new church.

The people of Los Lotes are also incredibly thankful that you were there for them after a volcano wiped out their entire village. In their greatest moment of need, you were quick to respond. Because of you, several families now have new homes and are able to begin rebuilding their lives after this horrible tragedy.

One of this year's highlights was being able to celebrate the completion of the state-of-the-art clinic you provided and furnished with medical equipment you helped ship. This clinic is going to save many lives, serving around 100,000 patients each year.

REFUGEE RELIEF

The numerous people living in refugee camps today never dreamed they would have to flee their homes. They were businesspeople, doctors, teachers, and pastors. They had nice homes and normal lives. Then, senseless violence stole everything from them – even food, clean water, and durable clothing.

But you made sure countless refugee families had the essentials they needed to survive. You helped restore their dignity and showed them they are not forgotten.

You helped fathers like Serkan. Serkan, whose name we've changed for safety, lost his wife in a bomb explosion near Mosul. He was left to care for their children on his own, and he couldn't even afford to buy them milk.

"My children have lost the right of having a mother; I don't want them to lose their health, too," Serkan said.

But your gifts helped provide the necessities refugees need. In Serkan's case, the healthy food he received helped keep his children alive and healthy.

Serkan is only one example of how your gifts have rescued refugees. They once felt alone and were almost on the brink of death. But you stepped in and helped save lives.



HUMANITARIAN AID

In the midst of a crisis, emergency items like food and medical supplies can be the difference between life and death. And by helping ship these and other lifesaving essentials, you made sure they reached men, women, and children as soon as possible to help in their moment of greatest need.

In 2018, you raised the funds to ship more than \$13 million worth of donated food, water, medical aid, and other critical items to nearly 600,000 people around the globe!

At least one-third of those supplies are earmarked for children in some of the poorest areas of the world. They will also help families facing famine, natural disasters, and violent clashes.

Imagine the joy when those shipments arrive in the communities that need them. Through shipments of humanitarian aid, you have helped meet the needs of the hungry, the sick, and the hurting. Your quick and generous response has delivered people from desperate, overwhelming circumstances — and introduced many to the hope of Christ.

NEPAL

The boys and girls at Grace Children's Home in Nepal continue to benefit from the beautiful, new building you provided after the previous one was destroyed by an earthquake. Even months after the completion of this construction project, the staff and students are still praising God for the bigger and better facilities.

Because of you, more than 70 children like Asmita continue to have a safe place to learn and grow.

Asmita was just 5 years old when her mother died. Her father couldn't support her alone; his average pay was less than \$2 a day. The situation seemed hopeless. She had no options and a bleak future.

Now that Asmita is at Grace Children's Home, though, she is enjoying a real childhood and a quality education. But without your involvement, none of that would have been possible. Asmita would have had nowhere to go.

Thank you for helping make sure that Asmita's story — and the stories of so many other children in Nepal — have a happy ending.

Your heart for helping children was evident when you rebuilt Grace Children's Home. Because of you, kids in Nepal are able to get an education and break the cycle of poverty.

Your support of church planters around the world has helped introduce countless people to the Truth, including Liuvis.

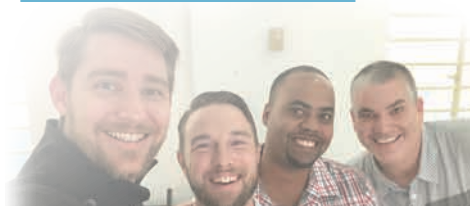
Liuvis is a young mom living in Cuba. Before she met Christ, her life was hopeless. She had an estranged relationship with her parents, and she felt like no one loved her. She was violent and, at one point, even considered suicide. The man she was dating was heavily involved in drugs and alcohol.

"Then someone touched his heart as well as mine," Luivis said. "That someone is called Jesus."

They heard the Good News at a local church planted in their community and decided to give their hearts to the Lord. "From that moment, our life took a complete turn," Luivis said. Her relationship with her parents was restored ... and now they are believers, too!

BIBLE DISTRIBUTION

This year alone, Kingdom Partners provided 4,634 Bibles worldwide. You helped flood spiritually dark places with the incredible light of God's Word. Thank you for your generosity!

For people living in North Korea, owning a Bible is an enormous risk. Being caught with one can mean imprisonment in a labor camp for 15 years — which is ultimately a death sentence. Still, North Korean believers are desperate for the Scriptures.

One group of secret Christians even meets on a fishing boat far out in the open water so they won't be spied reading God's Word and worshipping together. They hide their Bibles in fishing gear and once they are a long way from shore, they bring out their tattered copies to read and study.

And because of gifts like yours, this same group of Christians got new Bibles to replace those that were waterlogged and falling apart. They also made sure every member of their underground church had a copy.

Thank you for being fishers of men and spreading the Gospel even in the most unlikely places on earth.



CLEAN WATER

Kingdom Partners has always believed that the gift of water is life-changing for people in poverty. In 2018, you funded seven clean-water projects in five countries – India, Venezuela, Peru, El Salvador, and Guatemala.

Eduardo is a leader in one of the Guatemalan villages that will receive a new water well. He explained why this gift is so monumental for the community:

"Having clean water is very important for the health of the people because this vital liquid is used for cooking, drinking, or washing common objects like plates. We dreamed we could get clean water someday because we know it's a method for keeping good health."

By giving clean water, you have helped to rescue many people from water-related illnesses. Families have clean and reliable water to drink, cook with, grow vegetables, and care for livestock.



When you provided villages with clean water, you did more than give them something safe to drink. Your generosity has helped improve health, increased productivity, impacted economies, and restored hope.

And because people no longer have to walk long distances to collect water, they have more time for school and work. Your gift of water met more than just physical needs – it also helped improve a community's economy.



FREEDOM INITIATIVES

In India's Banchara community and the red-light districts of Thailand, girls don't dream about what they want to be someday. Their futures have been decided. Since most are too poor to get an education, they are left with only one choice – working in the sex industry.

But you gave many of these girls another choice. Thanks to your support over the years and because you went above and beyond at your Night of Freedom fundraiser this year, people like Kalena are now free.

Kalena, whose name we've changed to protect her identity, came to Bangkok to escape her abusive husband. She intended to work in a factory, but when she couldn't find a job, she was forced into Thailand's booming sex industry. Because of your support, however, Kalena was able to choose freedom.

Kalena went to live at the Freedom Center in Bangkok where she was given a chance to pursue a degree in textile design. Now, she is helping other girls learn a vocational skill by teaching them to sew!

Thank you for giving freedom to Kalena and many other girls like her. Your efforts enabled 325 girls to attend Freedom parties this year.

Choices are something most of us take for granted – but girls trapped in sexual slavery aren't so lucky. You decided they deserved to have choices, too. Your support has rescued young women from bondage and allowed them to experience freedom.
