Over the past several years, the country of Uganda has been flooded with refugees from South Sudan. These refugees have experienced brutal violence and are in desperate need of the hope that comes from Jesus. Unfortunately, many had to leave their Bibles behind when they ran or have never owned one at all. *Pray that refugees in Uganda will encounter God in the middle of their trials through the Scriptures.*

### PRAY FOR BIBLE SEEKERS IN CHINA

Bibles are extremely rare in China. The government allows them to be distributed only through state-sanctioned churches and restricts people from buying them online. One man said he tried for almost three years after becoming a Christian to get a Bible without success. *Pray God will put more Chinese believers in contact with the brave men and women covertly delivering Bibles there.*

### PRAY FOR NEW CONVERTS IN NIGERIA

Two Islamic terrorist groups – Boko Haram and the Fulani herdsmen – have terrorized Nigeria and displaced over 2 million people. One preacher working in the refugee camps said many refugees have converted from Islam to Christianity after seeing all the violence, and now they need Bibles, which are scarce in the camps. *Pray these men and women will receive copies of God's Word so they can learn more about His love.*
