CORONAVIRUS RELIEF

One of the biggest ways you helped rescue people in need this year was by providing emergency coronavirus relief like food, hygiene kits, medical care, and more.

Your quick response when the pandemic hit was the difference between life and death for people like Teléfara, a 71-year-old widow living in Nicaragua.

Every day Teléfara would push her cart to the market and pick through the garbage. She would sell some of the items she found and eat the rest.

"Despite the risk she runs in the streets of contracting COVID-19," our partner said, "she continues to go out. If she stayed at home, she would starve." Thankfully, your generosity helped deliver food bags full of rice, beans, and other staples to people like Teléfara before it was too late.



You also helped provide hygiene kits full of essentials like soap and hand sanitizer to families in need ... both in the U.S. and around the world.

And as our partners distributed the supplies you provided, they were able to share how your gift was Jesus' love in action.



HUMANITARIAN AID

Once again, you made an incredible impact around the world by shipping critical supplies like food, clothing, baby formula, medicine, medical equipment, and more to people who needed them most.

Your generous gifts made sure these lifesaving items didn't just sit on a shelf in our distribution center. You shipped them to men, women, and children who might not have survived without them.

Even though the annual Kingdom Partners Golf Tournament was canceled this September, you still raised nearly \$490,000 to send shipping containers packed with millions of dollars worth of emergency aid. That's almost \$90,000 more than your original goal!

You helped ship lifesaving supplies to places like:

- **Guatemala**, where starving families hung white flags as a cry for help
- **Zimbabwe**, where the pandemic left up to 80 percent of the population out of work
- **Haiti**, where people are still struggling from the effects of past natural disasters
- **And many more** including Nicaragua, Peru, Zambia, Jordan, Iraq, Honduras, Tanzania, Cuba, and Venezuela

Thank you for giving to help spread the name of Jesus throughout Cuba. Your impact has made an eternal difference in the lives of so many people!




REFUGEE RELIEF

Refugees continue to live in dirty, congested settlements. Although the media may not be talking about their struggles much anymore, you showed them that someone still cares.

Your support has been especially crucial for Syrian refugees like Rima. Families like hers have been living far from home for years, and they thought their situation couldn't get any worse. Then the pandemic hit. What little work was once available to them disappeared, and essentials like basic medical care were completely out of reach.

Rima, whose name we've changed to protect her, knew she needed a doctor when she started losing weight for no apparent reason. Even when she ate, she continued to drop pounds. She couldn't sleep at night, and her husband and kids were worried about her.

Thankfully, Rima was able to visit the clinic that YOU helped support and receive the treatment she needed. She's now gaining weight, sleeping better, and healthier than she has been in a very long time!



Not only do refugees like Rima receive the medical care they need, but the clinic staff also share God's love every time someone walks through their doors. They pray with each refugee who asks and preach a practical Gospel through every act of kindness.

Thank you for providing critical aid like food, clean water, clothing, blankets, medical care, and more to refugees like Rima.



DISASTER RELIEF

From the deadly Beirut explosion to Hurricane Eta in Guatemala, you raced to the front lines to help rescue disaster victims.

The massive explosion in Beirut, Lebanon, this summer left at least 5,000 people injured and more than 300,000 homeless. Kingdom Partners saw the need and responded immediately.

Your generosity helped provide emergency supplies like food, clean water, and medical care for families who lost everything in the blink of an eye. You stood by them in their darkest hour and showed them the love of God.

You were also there when communities in Louisiana were under water and littered with rubble from massive storms during hurricane season. And you helped families in Guatemala survive after massive flooding in November.

Thank you for jumping into action during times of crisis. Because of you, disaster victims and their families are on the road to recovery!

FREEDOM FROM SLAVERY

This year, Kingdom Partners continued to fight for the freedom of women and children affected by the sex industry in Thailand and India. You helped rescue them from a life of abuse, shame, and disease.

Your support and the money raised at the annual Night of Freedom event helped make sure Freedom Homes and sponsorship programs for kids impacted by the sex industry could keep their doors open.

You helped provide essentials like a safe place to live, counseling, medical care, education or vocational training, and more to people like Faa.

Faa, whose name we've changed, would be on a much different path without your help. She comes from a village in Thailand where many young girls her age are already pregnant. And many will grow up to sell their bodies night after night in the red-light districts.

"I know that if I had not come to [the Freedom Home] my future would be as dark as theirs. I never dreamed I could ever finish high school and go on to university. You have opened my eyes to possibilities!" — Faa

GUATEMALA

The effects of the pandemic hit Guatemala especially hard. Your generosity, though, helped families survive. And now, you continue to stand with these people as they recover from the devastating effects of Hurricane Eta.

Thanks to the Village Transformation completed by Kingdom Partners members in Tasharte, Guatemala, this community had plenty of clean water, food, and other necessities during lockdown. And when the village was hit by destructive winds and flooding from Hurricane Eta, they knew they could count on you to help set them on the path to recovery.

With your help, 117 special-needs children received the care they needed at Kelly's House this year. And the clinic you provided helped save many lives, treating all kinds of illnesses and even serving as an early treatment center for coronavirus patients.

Unfortunately, both Kelly's House and the clinic were significantly damaged by the historic storm in November. The people of Guatemala desperately need your continued support as they attempt to rebuild.

PROVIDING BIBLES AROUND THE WORLD

"When I was in school, I never read books. I forced teachers to give me grades by threatening them with a knife. I hated reading books that much. I graduated from school and lived as a robber.

"One day, I was angry without any reason and couldn't control my anger. At that moment, I happened to see the Bible I got from my friend, opened it, and read it.

"The next day, I wanted to read the Bible so much that I found a hidden place on the roof of a building to read it. I read the Bible for three days and called to God for the first time. God changed my life after I read the Bible."

SPONSORSHIP

This year's pandemic made life even more difficult for many children living in poverty. So your sponsorship was a lifeline! In 2020, Kingdom Partners supported 129 children in 15 countries.

Every child sponsored by Kingdom Partners receives regular access to healthy food, clean water, medical care, educational opportunities, and more. Even when schools were closed this year, sponsorship ensured these boys and girls continued to keep learning and receiving everything they needed, not to mention experiencing the love of Jesus.

Your sponsorship is helping to lift children like Leticia out of poverty.

Leticia comes from a very poor village in Uganda where it was hard for her parents to find jobs even before all the lockdowns. They would never have been able to afford a quality education for their daughter without the help of her sponsors.

But now, Leticia is on the path to a better future. She is excelling in her studies, loves learning English, and dreams of becoming a doctor when she grows up!

NEPAL

UGANDA

Kingdom Partners has always had a heart for Uganda and especially for this nation's children. Thank you for rescuing boys and girls through your support of children's homes and schools throughout the country.

The boys and girls at the Good Samaritan School in Kampala, Uganda, were sent home to live with their relatives due to lockdown regulations this year. However, because of your generosity, the staff was still able to check on the kids and their families to make sure that all of their needs were met until they returned.

The staff was also able to continue providing basic necessities for the students at the Kikooba campus even when school wasn't in session.

The kids at Destiny Villages of Hope were able to remain on at the children's program and shelter in place throughout the pandemic. In all three cases, the boys and girls were able to feel confident that they would be taken care of because of the way you have always taken care of them before. You made sure that the children from Destiny Villages of Hope had everything they needed throughout the pandemic, too.

Every time Kingdom Partners members provide another well, it means hundreds of people are rescued from potentially lethal waterborne diseases. It means children reclaim precious hours to study instead of fetching water. And it means families' gardens can flourish and produce healthy crops.

In places like the Banchara community of India, clean-water wells have also helped establish relationships of trust with the local leaders, opening doors for further opportunities to show God's love.

After one of the more recent wells in the Banchara community was constructed near the local school, our partner shared these words:

"This well will serve clean water to school children and staff which is a vital requirement while we focus on the Banchara community for the betterment of their future."

FUNDRAISING

Fundraising in 2020 looked a bit different than previous years, but you stayed committed to the cause and inspired others to join this global rescue mission, too.

Although many fundraising events were canceled this year, you found a way to still bring physical help and spiritual hope to people in desperate need around the world. In fact, those planning on attending the Annual Golf Tournament, Dinner, & Auction still managed to meet – and exceed! – the goal of \$400,000 to ship lifesaving supplies worldwide.

The first ever Virtual Night of Freedom also brought in thousands of dollars to help introduce women and children to freedom from the sex industry.

And even though the Nov. 2019 Turkey Wobble was rained out, it still raised over \$18,000 to provide clean water!

This year, Kingdom Partners provided more than \$508,222 through fundraisers!
