PRAY FOR SOUTH SUDAN

Families living in South Sudan are stuck between a rock and a hard place. In their home country, nonstop violence has led to a terrible famine. They can flee and head to Uganda, but the refugee camps there are already overflowing and cramped, and food is in short supply there too. *Pray that God will give comfort to the refugees in Uganda and pray for the more than 6.5 million who are still starving in South Sudan.*

PRAY FOR VENEZUELA

Venezuelans have been in the middle of an economic crisis for years, and that doesn't seem likely to change anytime soon. Unemployment is high and so is inflation. The prices of basic groceries have skyrocketed. Even though store shelves might not be empty like in a traditional famine, the fact that most families can't afford those groceries means a food shortage nonetheless. *Pray that families in Venezuela will be able to find work and that God will give them peace and meet their every need.*

PRAY FOR ZIMBABWE

Like many other countries facing severe famine, Zimbabwe has been suffering from a prolonged drought for years. And the food crisis is affecting children the most. According to one study, one in four children under the age of 5 in Zimbabwe suffers from stunted growth due to malnutrition. *Pray for children in Zimbabwe and around the world who are going to bed hungry tonight.*
