PRAY FOR FARMERS IN BURUNDI

Burundi is one of the poorest countries in the world, and the nation is also currently facing a drought. Since most of the population relies on agriculture for work, many families are struggling. Without water to irrigate their crops, farmers can't earn a living or feed their families. *Pray for families in Burundi as they face this drought. Pray they will be able to receive clean water to grow their crops.*

PRAY FOR SICK CHILDREN IN PERU

Many families in the remote villages of Peru do not have access to clean drinking water. As a result, many children struggle with waterborne diseases. PRAY FOR THE SAFETY OF WOMEN AND GIRLS IN UGANDA

In many African countries like Uganda, it is customary for women and girls to collect water for the family. But the roads to and from water sources are often dangerous. Criminals may wait along the path to rob or attack young women, and there's also the risk of running into a deadly animal. *Pray that these women and girls will receive clean water wells in their villages so they don't have to make these long, treacherous treks.*

PRAY FOR STUDENTS IN GUATEMALA

In Guatemala and many other developing nations, dirty water doesn't just steal a child's health ... it also steals his education. Every day he is sick from waterborne diseases means a day of school he can never get back. And if he falls too far behind, he may eventually drop out. *Pray for students in remote areas like the mountains of Guatemala where lack of clean water can be one more roadblock to a child's education.*

PRAY FOR CHRISTIANS IN SOUTH ASIA

Christians often face persecution in South Asian countries. Sometimes, they are even denied the right to use local water wells. By providing churches with water wells of their own, World Help's partners have found that they can grant these persecuted Christians access to clean water while also opening the doors to share the Gospel with community members when they come to collect water, too. *Pray more water wells will be built in South Asia to provide fresh, clean water and help introduce people to the Living Water.*
