# HUMANITARIAN AID CONTAINER SHIPMENTS FOR CORONAVIRUS RELIEF

**W**hen crisis, disaster, or poverty strike, World Help is uniquely equipped and positioned to meet the needs of people around the world. By working with national partners already on the ground, we are able to respond quickly and effectively to bring lifesaving aid to those who are suffering.

## RESPONDING TO THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

During this battle against the coronavirus and the economic crisis it has brought, many families around the world are on the losing side. They can't provide for themselves any longer. They need help now more than ever.

Our partners have expressed a need for more than 6,500,000 meals, which means we need to ship 25 containers of food between now and March 2021.

Generous food organizations have donated food for our partners at no charge. But we need YOUR help to cover the cost of shipping and handling.

You can help ship food to 12 of the countries suffering most from this pandemic, including:

- **Guatemala** – Families are literally hanging white flags outside their homes as a sign that they are out of food and starving.
- **Nicaragua** – Grocery prices have skyrocketed, and people who are out of work can't afford to buy daily meals. Poor nutrition makes them more vulnerable to getting sick.
- **Peru** – Many Peruvians live hand-to-mouth, buying only enough food for only one day at a time. Now they don't even have that.

**Additional countries:** Haiti, Zambia, Jordan, Iraq, Honduras, Tanzania, Zimbabwe, Cuba, and Venezuela.



## AID BY THE NUMBERS

**Our goal is to procure, ship, and distribute 25 containers with 6.5 million meals to 12 different countries, impacting about 161,850 lives.**

Sending containers to these countries costs, on average:
