



YOU HELPED RESCUE WOMEN FROM THE SEX INDUSTRY

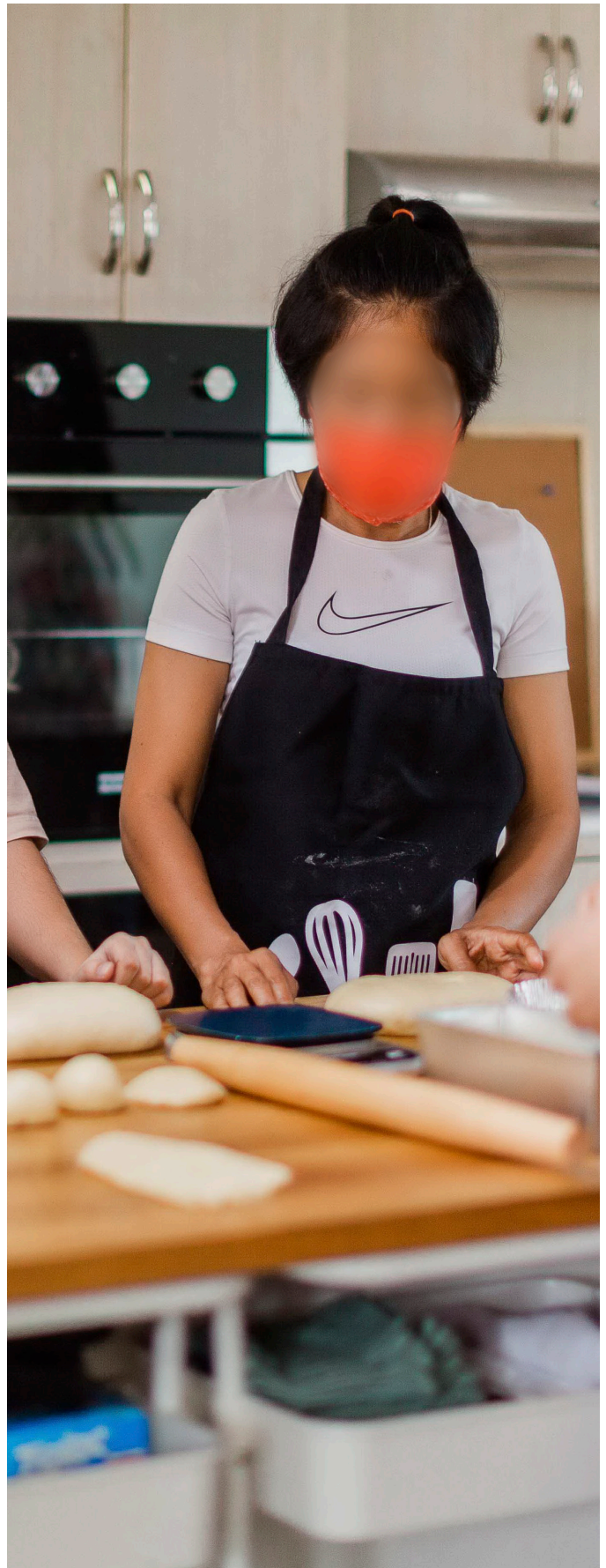

KAN AND MAY: FREEDOM FOR A MOM AND HER DAUGHTER

Kan* never planned to become a sex worker, but this single mom was determined to do whatever she had to in order to provide for her teenage daughter, May*. For a while, she worked in construction ... but her small wages were never enough. So Kan asked her brother to watch after her daughter and went to the city to find a job that provided more money.



At the Freedom Home's baking school, women like Kan are able to learn a valuable skill that they can turn into a career outside of the sex industry.

Instead, she ended up becoming a homeless sex worker, sleeping in a closet of the bar where she worked.

It was a horrible life. Kan's only comfort was that she was able to send a little money to her brother each month so he could take care of May.

What she didn't know was that her brother wasn't using the money for May. In fact, he had been forcing her to do manual labor to make more money and refused to feed her if she didn't work. He also rarely looked out for her protection, so while he was out of the house one day, May was attacked by a man in the community.

Desperate to escape, May fled to Pattaya to live with her mom. But around this same time, Kan was barely surviving herself. The bars had closed because of the pandemic, so Kan had no way to make money and provide for herself, much less her daughter. She was worried they both would starve.

Then, everything changed. Kan met some of the staff from the Freedom Home who were distributing food during the lockdown. They fed Kan and May and told them about the Freedom Home.

Both mom and daughter were eager to learn more ... and today, they are on their way to freedom! May is now settled in school, getting a good education so she can start a career someday, while her mom is taking classes at the Freedom Home's baking school so she can leave the sex industry for good.
