WEEK 1

Aug. 29 -
Sept. 4

PRAY FOR DISPLACED PEOPLE WITH LITTLE FOOD OR WATER

Men, women, and children are fleeing the Taliban by any means necessary. Many are sleeping out in the open with no food or water because they don't know where to go next. *Pray that these families receive the supplies they need to survive.*

WEEK 2

Sept.
5 - 11

PRAY ESPECIALLY FOR WOMEN AND GIRLS

Last time the Taliban was in control of Afghanistan, women were banned from the workplace, commanded to cover their faces, and even publicly executed. The Taliban claims this time will be different, but many women are scared they will be targets once again. *Please pray for their safety and that they will not lose the rights they have fought for over the last 20 years.*

WEEK 3

12 - 18

PRAY FOR CHRISTIANS AT RISK FOR PERSECUTION

The Taliban see Christianity as a Western religion and a threat, so Christians are another group that is particularly at risk of being targeted. *Pray that Afghan Christians will remain strong in their faith and show God's love to those around them.*

PRAY FOR HEALTH IN CROWDED CAMPS

As people on the run crowd into temporary shelters and displacement camps, they are even more vulnerable to the spread of the coronavirus and other diseases. *Pray that God will protect their health and provide them with the medical care that they need.*

Oct. 2

PRAY FOR SUPERNATURAL PEACE

The future of Afghanistan remains unclear. Displaced families don't know when, if ever, it will be safe to return home or how long this crisis will last. *Pray that God will give His supernatural peace and comfort to Afghans facing uncertainty.*
