PRAY FOR DISPLACED FAMILIES RUNNING FOR THEIR LIVES

Since the start of the Russian invasion on Feb. 24, millions of Ukrainians have fled their homes. Many of them packed whatever they could in a matter of minutes, boarded crowded trains, and are now struggling to survive with little more than the clothes on their backs. Some have escaped across the border. Others are still hiding within Ukraine. *Pray that God would supply the basic needs of these families living in fear.*

WEEK 2

PRAY FOR UKRAINIANS FIGHTING FOR THEIR COUNTRY'S FREEDOM

Around 80 percent of Ukrainian refugees are women. That's because men ages 18-60 are required to stay behind and serve on the battlefield. Rather than evacuating, they've had to say goodbye to the women and children they love. *Pray for the safety of Ukrainian men and women who are bravely defending their country during this time.*

PRAY FOR OUR PARTNERS HELPING PEOPLE ON THE GROUND

Right now, our partners in Ukraine and surrounding countries are working day and night to help as many displaced men, women, and children as possible. They've set up refugee centers where families can eat, sleep, and shower before moving to the next transit point. *Pray that our global partners will have the strength and resources to continue meeting these urgent needs.*

PRAY FOR PEACE TO BE RESTORED IN UKRAINE

It's impossible to know when the conflict in Ukraine will end. Every day seems to bring a new report on more bombings and evacuations. Thankfully, we know Who is in control, and none of this has taken God by surprise. *Pray that this conflict will soon be over and that families will be reunited.*
