WEEK 1

July
3 - 9

PRAY FOR NORTH KOREANS INFECTED BY THE CORONAVIRUS

Since the coronavirus pandemic began spreading around the world in early 2020, the North Korean government has claimed zero cases – until several weeks ago. North Korea reported its first confirmed case on May 12, and the virus has continued to spread. Unfortunately, a lack of test kits and vaccines is making the outbreak difficult to control. *Pray for the healing of those infected and that the spread of the virus will slow soon.*

WEEK 2

July
10 - 16

PRAY FOR PEOPLE BATTLING SEVERE INTESTINAL DISEASE

In addition to a coronavirus outbreak, North Korea is also experiencing the spread of a “mystery stomach disease.” The symptoms are similar to typhoid, dysentery, and cholera, which are often caused by contaminated food and water. *Pray that God will give the doctors wisdom in treating this illness and that those who are sick will have a speedy recovery.*

WEEK 3

July
17 - 23

PRAY FOR FAMILIES FACING EXTREME HUNGER

There are several factors contributing to North Korea’s ongoing food shortage – droughts, contaminated water supplies, and disrupted supply chains with bordering countries. With little rain and only polluted water at their disposal, farmers are struggling to keep crops healthy. And fewer imported goods mean grocery store shelves remain bare while prices skyrocket. *Pray that hungry North Korean families can find and afford the food they need to survive.*

WEEK 4

24 - 30**

PRAY FOR GOD'S LIGHT TO PENETRATE THE DARKNESS

North Korea has always been one of the most dangerous places to be a Christian. But believers are no longer just enduring religious persecution. They're also facing famine, disease, a shaky economy, and much more. This nation desperately needs a touch from the Lord. *Pray that God would do a mighty work in North Korea and bring it out of the darkness.*
