One of Burundi's biggest planting seasons begins in September, but many farmers can't afford the skyrocketing prices of fertilizer. This is a serious threat to a country where 90% of the population depends on agriculture to make a living. *Pray for farmers in Burundi to have productive planting and harvest seasons so they can help feed hungry families.*

PRAY FOR FAMILIES IN INDIA WHO CAN'T AFFORD GROCERIES

India had one of the strictest lockdowns during the height of the pandemic. As a result, many families lost jobs, and now they're struggling to recover as food prices continue to soar. "Prices of vegetables, grains, cooking oil, fuel, spices, and whatnot have gone so high that for poor people like us, starvation has come back [more] severe than [during] COVID lockdown," one father said. *Pray for these families as they struggle to feed their children each day.*

PRAY FOR UGANDANS LIVING ON JUST A FEW DOLLARS PER DAY

Uganda used to get much of its wheat and corn from Ukraine, but the Russian invasion has stopped the flow of these food staples into the country. Now flour alone costs 72% more than it did last year! That means Ugandan families who were already earning less than \$2 a day are finding it even harder to put food on the table. *Pray that God would provide the income and nutrition these people need to survive.*

PRAY FOR FAMILIES DIGGING THROUGH LANDFILLS IN HONDURAS

In Honduras, the price of basics like cooking oil have more than doubled this year. Even onions cost almost twice as much as they used to, and what you used to pay for one package of meat or eggs will now only get you about two-thirds as much as before. That's devastating for Hondurans, especially for the poorest families who spend their days digging through local trash dumps for recyclables they can sell for pennies. *Pray for the economy to be restored in Honduras so families don't have to take these extreme measures.*
