WEEK 1

PRAY FOR COMMUNITIES AFFECTED BY THE EBOLA OUTBREAK

Dozens of people have died since the deadly Ebola outbreak began in September. The Mubende and Kassanda districts are the epicenter of the disease, so strict lockdowns are being enforced in those areas, including nightly curfews, bans on public transportation, and the closure of churches and other venues. *Pray for a swift end to the outbreak and for protection over the people of Uganda.*

PRAY FOR UGANDA'S STRUGGLING HEALTH CARE SYSTEM

Every year, hundreds of doctors and other health care workers leave Uganda to find better pay in developed countries. There are currently 4,000 vacant positions throughout Ugandan hospitals, which means families are left with very limited access to medical care. *Pray for the system to be restored so people can receive treatment – especially during this time of crisis.*

PRAY FOR THE COUNTRY'S GOVERNMENT AND LEADERSHIP

With Uganda facing so many challenges right now, the country's leadership greatly needs your prayers. You can pray, in particular, for President Yoweri Museveni as he has to make many important decisions for the nation every day. Another prayer request is that lawmakers will enact policies that would help poor Ugandans and expand access to education and women's rights. *Pray that those in positions of power make the best decisions for all Ugandans.*

PRAY FOR UGANDAN CHILDREN TO HAVE ACCESS TO EDUCATION

Many boys and girls in Uganda struggle to get the education they need. Families often have up to eight children, but schools don't have the space or resources to accommodate them all, which often means only one or two kids from each family can attend school. *Pray for these children to receive an education so they can escape a life of poverty.*

PRAY FOR CHRISTIANS IN UGANDA TO REMAIN STRONG

As the Muslim population in Uganda grows, so does the Islamic faith. Our partners said the Muslims' beautiful mosques are a stark contrast to Christian churches that are practically falling apart across the country. *Pray for Christians in Uganda to be bold and keep sharing the Gospel, even when they're surrounded by Islam and other false doctrines.*
