UKRAINE

When Russia launched a full-scale invasion in Ukraine, your gifts rushed in to provide lifesaving aid for men, women, and children displaced by war.

Kingdom Partners has played a crucial role in helping displaced Ukrainian families survive the past year. Many of these refugees fled their homes with little more than the clothes on their backs, but your generosity helped meet the urgent needs of people like Yana.

Back in February, Yana's family woke up early one morning to the sound of explosions. They fled to Yana's grandmother's house, but Russian airstrikes began raining bombs on that part of the city, too.

They had no choice but to leave their home and head for Lviv, but the trip was long and exhausting. The train was so overcrowded that Yana, her husband, and their 6-year-old son had to sit on their bags during the entire 19-hour train ride. When they arrived in Lviv, though, they were immediately given food, clothing, and shelter thanks to the support of people like you!



These supplies were exactly what the family needed in that moment as they prepared for the next leg of their refugee journey. **Thank you for giving to help Ukrainian refugees like Yana and her family and showing them God's love in a practical way.**



GLOBAL REFUGEE RELIEF

In addition to helping displaced Ukrainians, Kingdom Partners continues to stand with people all around the world who have been refugees for years – even when the news media and many others have moved on.



Afghanistan

Ever since the Taliban takeover, you have helped distribute emergency food and other essentials to displaced Afghan families running for their lives. “Before your support, we didn’t have anything at home for eating, and nobody helped us,” one refugee said. “Now, my children and wife are so happy after receiving your help.”



Syria

The Syrian civil war has been raging for more than a decade, and there are more refugees in the world from Syria than from any other country. But thanks to you, many Syrian families continue to have access to food, medical care, education, and more.



Iraq

Kingdom Partners also continues to support a mobile clinic for hundreds of displaced families in Iraq. Through this clinic, refugees can receive the medicines they need for chronic conditions, emergency medical treatment for injuries and illnesses, and routine check-ups to ensure they remain healthy.

You have truly been the hands and feet of Jesus to refugees, reminding them they are not forgotten.



SHIPPING HUMANITARIAN AID

You made a global impact by helping ship life-changing aid like food, clothing, baby care items, medical equipment, God's Word, and more to thousands of people in need.

At this year's Kingdom Partners Golf Tournament, you raised over **\$535,000** — enough to ship **\$8.5 million** worth of emergency aid.

Your generosity provided help and hope for people like Andreus:

Andreus is an elderly grandmother living in Haiti. Her husband died in 2019 just before the pandemic started, so she's had to endure lockdowns and the recent rise of food costs on her own. Plus, she cares for two of her grandchildren full-time, making it difficult for her to work and earn an income to buy food.

But thanks to your generosity, Andreus received boxes of nutrient-fortified rice, which will keep her and her grandchildren strong and healthy.

BUILDING HOPE CAMPAIGN

After hearing about the need to build a bigger Aid & Relief warehouse, you quickly came on board to ensure World Help could ship lifesaving supplies to even more people every year.

This year, you took part in one of World Help's most ambitious building projects ever. You gave generously to help build the new Louanne Guillermin Humanitarian Aid Distribution Center. This new space was desperately needed to meet the increasing demand of shipping containers our partners need to serve their communities. And when the old warehouse space we were renting was suddenly taken over by another company, your support became even more critical.

The 26,250-square-foot building is now complete and will help ship at least \$16.5 million worth of aid annually. That's enough to impact over 1.3 million people every year!

And we expect that over time, this new warehouse will allow all of World Help's Aid & Relief operations to triple — that means 3x as many volunteer hours donated each year, 3x as many containers shipped annually, and 3x as many people helped.

This huge endeavor wouldn't have been possible without your support. Thank you for stepping out in faith and giving to help make this dream a reality.



GUATEMALA

Life in Guatemala hasn't been easy this past year. As prices skyrocketed around the globe, many Guatemalans found it hard to afford even the most basic necessities. But your generosity – both past and present – made sure they had everything they needed.

The community of Tasharte continues to flourish after the Village Transformation completed by Kingdom Partners members, which provided a new church building and pastor's home, school building, and clean-water project. Kingdom Partners donors also provided food bags for all 648 families in the village this year.

"We are very grateful for the food bags you have given us," one woman from Tasharte said. "It is a blessing to receive the support that each of you gives us from so far away."

Your previous support of the Hope of Life medical clinic and Kelly's House also continues to have a long-lasting impact on the people of Guatemala. At Kelly's House alone, 141 special needs children are receiving the help they need to thrive ... and you've played a major part in that.

God has used you to do great things in Guatemala, and your impact will continue to change lives for years to come!

FIGHTING FOR FREEDOM

Once again, Kingdom Partners paved a way for vulnerable women and children to escape the sex industries of Thailand and India. Your generosity helped them experience a life of freedom!

Your impact in Thailand and India is far-reaching. The Freedom Homes you've given to are providing girls and young women with the tools they need to find good jobs beyond the sex industry. And the preschool you support in the Bang Na slum continues to provide a safe haven and a quality education to boys and girls living just outside of Thailand's red-light district.

During this year's Night of Freedom event, over \$66,000 was raised to support child sponsorship programs serving children at risk of exploitation in Thailand. Not to mention, 28 children received a full-time sponsor!

Thank you for giving women and children like Nan hope for a better future!

Nan was just 6 years old when she arrived at one of the Thailand Freedom Homes. With no birth record and her parents out of the picture, Nan was considered stateless. She had no legal rights, no protection, and access to only a limited education. Without help, she most likely would have ended up on the streets selling her body.

But you helped change that! Nan is now in middle school, and instead of that withdrawn, scared, and severely malnourished 6-year-old who arrived at the Freedom Home, she's now confident and a wonderful leader for the other girls. Nan is receiving a quality education and even attends weekly Bible studies.

Your involvement has allowed girls like Nan to escape a life of abuse.



PROVIDING BIBLES WORLDWIDE

Thank you for sending Bibles all around the world! Some went to families who had been praying for a Bible but couldn't afford one. Others went to the underground church to be distributed in secret. Now, these people can read the Gospel in their language.

Because of you, God's Word has reached every corner of the globe — from South Asia to Iran to Burundi and beyond. You've even placed Bibles in the hands of North Koreans.

North Korea is one of the most dangerous places on earth to be a Christian, but people continue to beg for Bibles so they can learn more about God. On top of that, the country is also facing a devastating famine. Your gifts helped meet both these needs, equipping our partners to distribute food as well as copies of God's Word through their underground network.

One North Korean Christ-follower shared this after receiving a Bible in the North Korean dialect for the first time:

"The North Korean Bible allows me to read the Word of God. It touched my heart and was easily understood. I pray that the day when all North Koreans will receive this Bible as soon as possible and live under God's grace will come very soon."

As a result of your giving, that dream of Bibles in the hands of every North Korean is a little bit closer to coming true. **Thank you, again, for spreading the Word of God around the globe and giving people the opportunity to grow closer to God.**



CLEAN WATER

Clean water is one of the most important resources in the world, and in 2022, Kingdom Partners provided multiple villages in need with life-changing wells.

Thank you for providing people like Juan with clean water.

Juan is a 47-year-old man living in Guatemala. Before his community received a clean-water well, he'd have to leave the village and walk long distances to the nearest spring whenever he needed water. Not only did it take time out of his day, but it also put him and everyone else in the village at risk of dangerous waterborne diseases.

But thanks to Kingdom Partners donors, it's not a problem anymore! It takes Juan less than 30 minutes to get the water he needs from the new well, compared to the hours it took before. The water is clean and fresh, so everyone can drink safely.

Juan was so grateful to finally have access to clean water! He said, "We do not know how to pay you back for this beautiful gift, but we will keep you in our prayers and we will ask God to bless you greatly for the great support you have provided for us."



In addition to Guatemala, you helped build six wells in countries like Zambia, India, El Salvador, and Nepal. Thank you for providing people like Juan with safe, reliable access to this life-giving resource!



NEPAL

The children and staff at Grace Children's Home still talk about how incredibly grateful they are for the support you gave them in the wake of the 2015 earthquake in Nepal.

This year, six young men and women who grew up at Grace Children's Home graduated from high school. These graduates were around 12 or 13 years old when the historic quake hit, so they remember it well.

They remember the fear and the uncertainty in the days that followed. Where would they live? Would they be able to continue their schooling? But they also remember the incredible feeling of relief that came as you stepped in and helped them rebuild.

Because you chose to get involved, these boys and girls didn't have to abandon their dreams. And now, they are graduating and starting college or careers!

Rashmi, one of the graduates who hopes to become an accountant, had this to say about her graduation:

"Because of your great support and love toward me today, I am able to complete my high school studies. It is a very big achievement for me. Thank you very much for everything you have done for me and my family. I have no words to express how grateful I am for your support and prayers. I am planning to pursue my education further at the bachelor level."



INDIA

Your continued support of Gilgal Children's Home is helping hundreds of boys and girls escape poverty!

India is often called the "poverty capital of the world." Many children in the poorest communities don't have access to daily essentials like food, education, and medical care. But with the support of Kingdom Partners like you, the children of Gilgal Children's Home have the resources they need to build a better future.

Schools in India were closed for nearly two years due to COVID-19 lockdowns. However, your generosity helped these boys and girls keep their education on track through online learning, and now they're excited to be back in the classroom with their teachers and friends!

Your gifts have been a powerful reminder to the boys and girls of Gilgal that God loves them. Thank you for giving!

UGANDA

In 2022, Kingdom Partners continued to show love to the children of Uganda. Together, you sponsored 23 children and supported three children's homes across the country.

Because of you, children like Purity have a bright future ahead of them! Purity is 13 years old and attends the Good Samaritan School in Kampala, Uganda. She receives essentials at school that she can't always get at home, like nutritious food, medical care, and an education.

This past April, Purity even had the chance to celebrate her birthday with other children in the program! Birthday celebrations like this one are a rare treat for children living in poverty and a special reminder of how much they are loved.

CUBA CHURCH PLANTING

A spiritual revival is happening across Cuba right now, and you are helping to fan the flames and spread the Gospel to those who have never heard it before.

Over the past year, World Help's church planting partners in Cuba have seen 8,152 declarations of faith, 481 baptisms, and the start of 57 house churches. And you played a part in that!

Your gifts also contributed toward providing church planters with 7,000 Bibles to distribute as well as shoes and other essentials for their families. With the needs of their families taken care of, they were able to focus more attention on planting churches and sharing the Gospel.

One church plant took place in a remote Cuban village that takes anywhere from one to three hours to reach because of how far removed it is from the main roads. "Many people here have been deep into Santeria practices and alcoholism," one church planter said. Santeria is a combination of Catholicism and African folklore.

These people worshipped false gods ... but now they know the one true God. They used to have no hope, our Cuban partner said, but now, miracles have happened!

Thank you for your commitment to making Jesus known throughout Cuba.



CHILD SPONSORSHIP

Kingdom Partners sponsored 167 children this year in countries all around the world — including places like Guatemala, Thailand, and India! That's 20 more kids than last year who received the physical and spiritual help they desperately needed.

Every child sponsored by Kingdom Partners receives access to essentials like educational opportunities, medical care, nutritious meals, clean water, and more. Plus, they also experience the love of Jesus through their caring teachers, mentors, and — of course — their sponsors!

Sponsorship makes a life-changing impact for children like Pinhas.

After Pinhas's family experienced intense persecution for being Christ-followers in South Asia, God opened the door for him to live at a children's home in another city and receive a sponsor. Here's how he described his sponsorship experience:

"I have been enjoying my time by engaging in different activities such as sports, devotions and worship, church services, Bible reading, group activities, and much more. I love playing cricket. I get good food, and I am being well taken care of. This year I will be completing my schooling, and I am very excited to finish and get enrolled in college to pursue my degree in finance management. [Sponsorship] is the reason I am what I am today, and it could not have been possible to reach this level without help. I thank God for all these wonderful things He has done in my life."





FUNDRAISING

Kingdom Partners organized four impactful events in the past year, and through these events, thousands of lives were transformed around the world.

At this year's Night of Freedom event, you provided help and hope for children affected by the sex industry. During the Kingdom Partners Golf Tournament, you helped ship lifesaving supplies worldwide. The money raised at the Charity Classic Golf Tournament helped meet some of the most urgent needs around the globe. And last year's Turkey Wobble provided five clean-water wells in places like Guatemala, Haiti, and Uganda!
