Russian bombs have destroyed the roofs and walls of homes across the country, leaving people exposed to the elements. *Please pray for emergency aid like warm clothing, generators, and fuel to be sent to the people who need it most in Ukraine.*

PRAY FOR CHURCHES IN UKRAINE AND SURROUNDING COUNTRIES

Internally displaced Ukrainians and refugees in surrounding countries are flooding local churches. They come hoping to find physical aid like food, water, medicine, and shelter.
