Over a year has passed since Russia launched its full-scale invasion of Ukraine. Since then, over 8 million Ukrainians have fled to neighboring countries – most of whom are women and children. Now on their own in a new country, women are more likely to experience gender-based violence ... and children face an increased risk of exploitation. After surviving a brutal winter, their spirits are left worse for wear. They're tired, scared, and desperate to return home to their loved ones. *Please pray for God to bring a swift and peaceful resolution to the war in Ukraine.*

## PRAY FOR AFGHAN WOMEN WHO ARE LOSING THEIR RIGHTS

After more than 40 years of conflict, the Afghan refugee crisis is now the third largest in the world – made worse by the Taliban's violent takeover of the government in 2021. Of these refugees, almost 80% are women and children. And under Sharia law, these women are losing their fundamental rights. Many young girls aren't even allowed to attend school anymore. *Please pray for the Holy Spirit to change the hearts and minds of Islamic extremists in Afghanistan.*
