PRAY FOR PEOPLE SUFFERING FROM THE ONGOING FAMINE IN NORTH KOREA

Since North Korea closed its borders in 2020 and reduced the amount of aid coming into the country, the people have struggled under the weight of a growing hunger crisis. To make matters worse, recurrent droughts and floods are causing crops to fail. The famine in North Korea is becoming critical, and people are starving to death in their homes. *Please pray that North Koreans will have enough food to survive and that their crops will recover.*

PRAY FOR THE ECONOMY TO RECOVER IN LEBANON

Lebanon's failing economy resulted in more than skyrocketing prices and political unrest – it's also resulted in a historic food shortage. Now, over one million people are going hungry. In 2023 alone, food prices have almost tripled, and people are borrowing money just to eat. Children are working instead of attending school, and malnutrition rates are rising. *Pray that Lebanon's economy will recover so people can afford to feed their families.*

PRAY FOR PEOPLE FACING DANGER AND FOOD SHORTAGES IN HAITI

Haiti has one of the highest food insecurity rates in the world, with nearly half the population facing acute hunger. Since Haiti's president was assassinated in 2021, gangs have taken over much of the capital, and people can't find jobs or food. And with 59% of the country living in poverty, rising unemployment rates and food shortages mean people are starving. *Pray that God would provide food for the people of Haiti and that peace would be restored.*

PRAY FOR FARMERS AND PEOPLE GOING HUNGRY IN NIGERIA

In Nigeria, over 24 million people don't have enough food. The region's intense rainfalls may seem like they'd help improve harvests, but instead, they often cause floods that destroy crops and farmland. And, in recent months, farmers across the country have fallen victim to brutal attacks from armed groups. These groups are putting farmers in constant danger and contributing to the increasing food shortage. *Please pray for the safety of farmers in Nigeria and for a successful crop harvest this year.*
