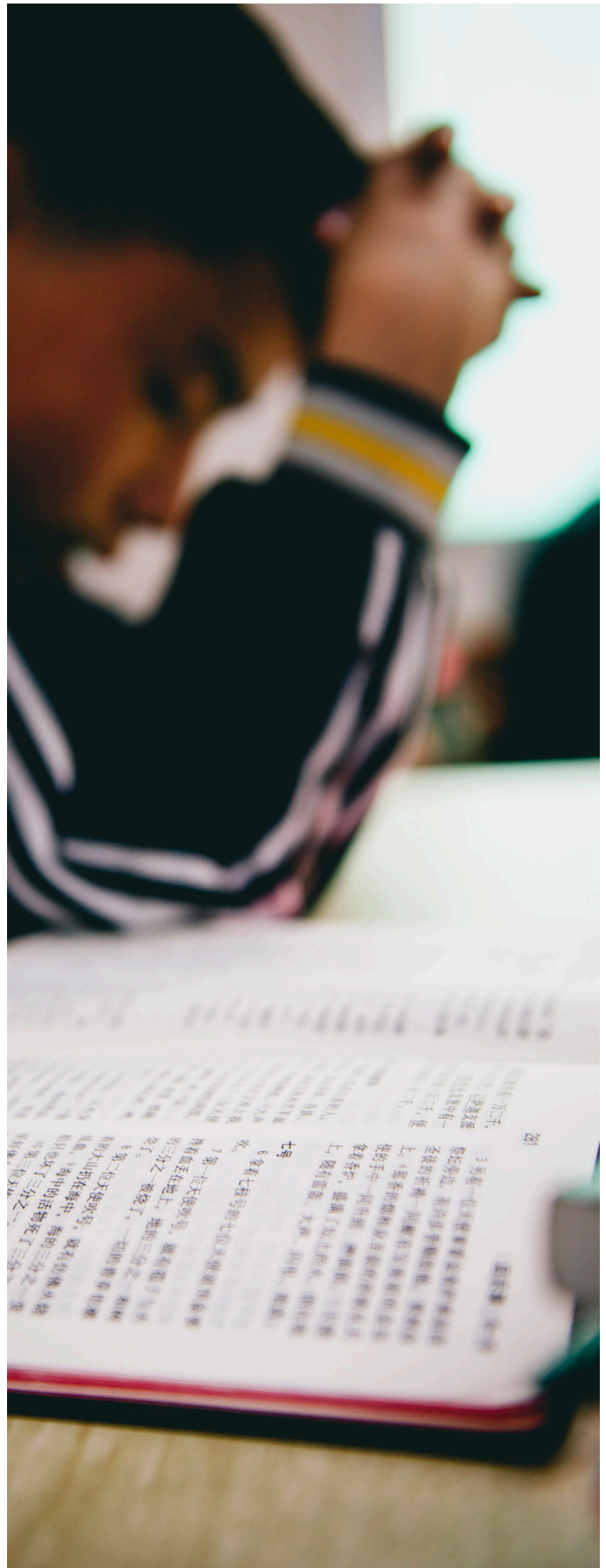

“The 60 small palm-sized Bibles disappeared without a trace,” our partner said. “I think they took them one by one when no one was looking.”
