WEEK 1

March
3 - 9

PRAY FOR STRUGGLING WOMEN IN UKRAINE AND EASTERN EUROPE

Almost 70 percent of Ukrainian refugees and displaced people are women. Many haven't seen their husbands, fathers, or sons since the invasion began. Driven from their homes by war, many women struggle to find jobs and provide for their families on their own. They have no idea when they'll be able to return home or what they'll find when they do. *Please pray that God would provide comfort and support to struggling Ukrainian women and their families.*

WEEK 2

10 - 16

PRAY FOR WOMEN FACING POVERTY AND INJUSTICE IN AFGHANISTAN

Since the Taliban took control of Afghanistan in 2021, girls and women have become victims of growing gender-based oppression. Most girls are banned from going to school, and women aren't allowed to leave their homes without a male chaperone. Afghanistan is also grappling with a failing economy, and many women and their families have fallen into severe poverty. Women can't work to afford food and other essentials, so they can't feed their families. *Pray that women in Afghanistan would win their fight for freedom and see their rights restored.*

WEEK 3

PRAY FOR WOMEN AFFECTED BY THE GLOBAL WATER CRISIS

When clean water is unattainable for families in need, women are especially affected. Mothers and girls often must walk miles to get water instead of going to school or caring for their families. It's exhausting and keeps them from receiving an education or going to work. Plus, the water they get is often dirty and dangerous to drink. Waterborne diseases keep many girls from attending classes even when they have the time. *Pray that God would provide clean water to families and communities who need it most.*

PRAY FOR WOMEN TRAPPED IN THE SEX TRADE

Thousands of women in Thailand and India are trapped in the sex industry. Girls in Thailand are expected to be the breadwinners of their families. Those living in poverty without an education struggle to find work, and they're often pushed into the sex trade to survive. Meanwhile, the Banchara community in India has prostitution ingrained in their culture. When the oldest girl in a family turns 12, she begins her life as a sex worker ... and she'll likely continue until her body gives out. *Please pray that these girls will find lasting freedom and experience the love of Christ.*
