2 - 8

PRAY FOR PEOPLE EXPERIENCING AN EXTREME DRY SEASON IN ZAMBIA

Zambia is in the middle of its driest agricultural season in over four decades. This drought has affected nearly half of the country's population. Without rain, many people are food insecure because of crop failure. They also lack access to safe, clean drinking water. With no end to the drought in sight, countless men, women, and children in Zambia desperately need water. *Pray that God would end the drought in Zambia so people can have enough food and water.*

PRAY FOR INDIAN MEN, WOMEN, AND CHILDREN AFFECTED BY A WORSENING DROUGHT

Over one-fourth of India is suffering from rising temperatures and insufficient rain. As groundwater dries up, millions of people face a critical water shortage. Lack of precipitation is also putting vital crops at risk, which could lead to a food shortage. Now, people in India fear they won't have access to clean water and other essentials. *Please pray for God to bring enough rain to India to help crops grow and replenish important water sources.*

PRAY FOR PEOPLE IN PERU STRUGGLING TO SURVIVE DURING AN ONGOING DROUGHT

Unusual weather patterns in Central and South America have resulted in an especially long dry season in Peru. Millions of Peru's residents already rely on the government for their drinking water, and now the drought is endangering the country's limited supply. Farmers are suffering, too. Without rain, their crops can't grow, which could soon lead to a food shortage nationwide. *Please pray for an end to the drought in Peru so people can live safe and healthy lives.*

PRAY FOR PEOPLE FACING POVERTY IN MALAWI BECAUSE OF A SEVERE DROUGHT

Malawi has declared a state of emergency as an ongoing drought ravages the nation. People are being plunged into poverty as farmers lose valuable crops and food supplies run low. Rising temperatures are making the situation worse. Many people also lack reliable access to clean water and must rely on humanitarian aid. *Pray that the drought in Malawi will end soon so civilians can have consistent access to food and clean water.*
