The Need

For over two decades, the people of Uganda suffered under the violent reign of the Lord's Resistance Army (LRA), which led to mass civilian massacres and displacements that impacted over 1.5 million people. Today, the country is still dealing with the effects, especially widespread poverty. Many families have limited access to essentials like clean water, proper sanitation, and medical care. Children are particularly vulnerable to disease under these conditions, and a lack of educational access also means that many children from Uganda will be trapped in poverty their entire lives.

How You Can Help

To help break this cycle, World Help's in-country partners have established several Christian schools serving children from some of Uganda's poorest communities. However, these children in these programs need sponsors to cover the cost of their education and other essentials.

By supporting these children, your church will provide them with the ability to learn, grow, and achieve their dreams. You will provide them with resources like daily meals, school uniforms and supplies, basic medical care, and a quality education.
