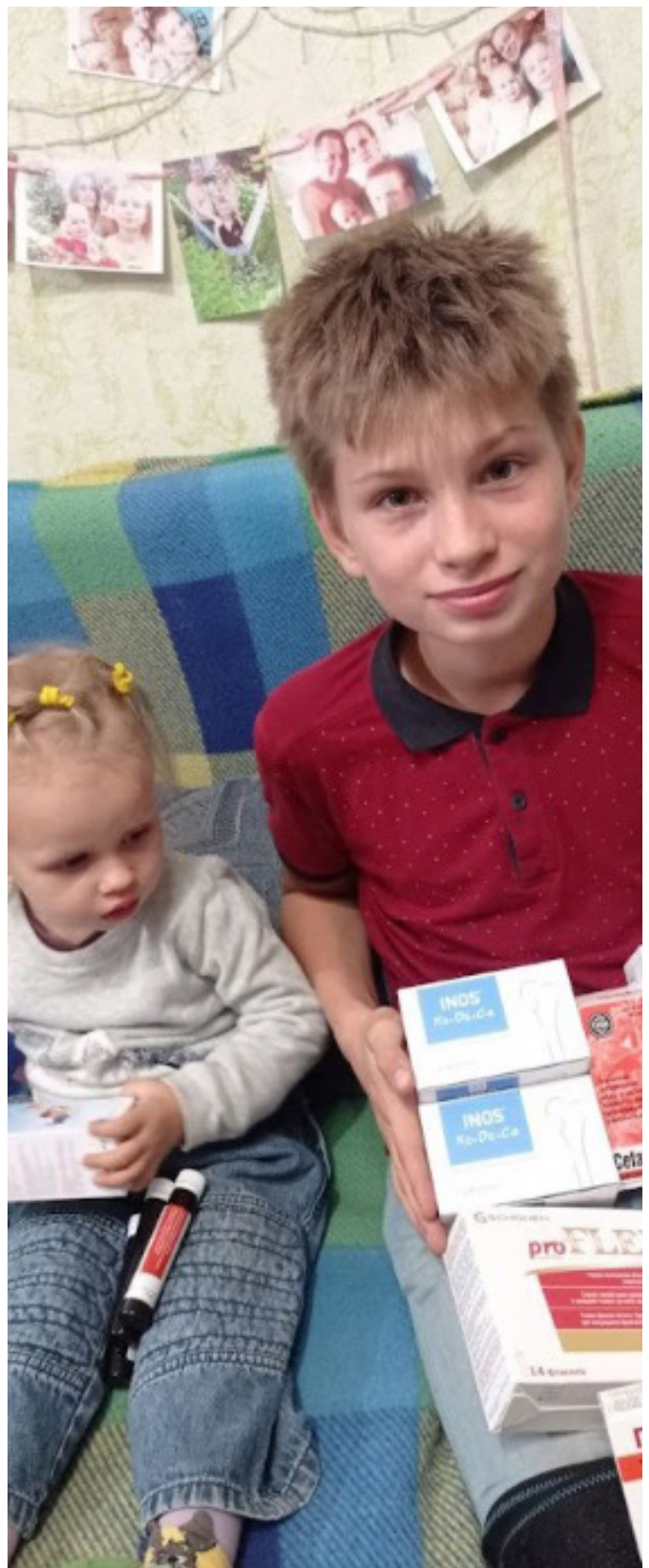
Here are two testimonies to give you a glimpse at the impact you've made worldwide:

Marwa is the eldest daughter in her family, and at just 14 years old, her life has been anything but easy.

In 2013, her family fled the violence in Syria and resettled in Jordan. Not long after, Marwa's younger brother was born with a cleft lip and palate, requiring multiple surgeries and ongoing medical treatment.

With the small income her father earns as a painter, Marwa's parents struggled to pay her brother's medical bills while also providing for Marwa and her sisters.

For Marwa, something as simple as a pair of shoes was a luxury that her family couldn't afford. She went to school without them each day – until you stepped in. Because of generous supporters like you, Marwa received brand-new shoes!

"When my daughters received the new shoes, I saw smiles I hadn't seen in a long time. For her, it was more than shoes – it was a reminder that people care about us and want us to succeed," her mother said.
