## WEEK 1

### **PRAY CHURCH PLANTERS WOULD IMPACT THEIR COMMUNITIES FOR CHRIST**

In these situations, church planters may struggle to form friendships or even share the Gospel. In more serious cases, they may even be exiled from the community. *Please pray that God would open the hearts of unreached communities to church planters and the Good News of Christ.*

## WEEK 2

### **PRAY CHURCH PLANTERS WOULD REMAIN FAITHFUL IN THEIR WORK**

Church planting is a long process that requires patience, resilience, and hard work. Church planters may find themselves celebrating one week and drained and discouraged the next. *Pray that God would help church planters stay faithful, encouraged, and focused on finishing His work through every trial and success.*

## WEEK 3

### **PRAY THE GOSPEL WOULD TRANSFORM LIVES IN UNREACHED AREAS**

When church planters establish churches, they long to see the Gospel transform lives. The purpose of their work is to spread the Good News of Christ to the unreached so they can have eternal life. But ultimately, they know only Jesus can truly transform hearts and change lives. *Pray that God would continue to draw people to Jesus through the efforts of church planters worldwide.*

## WEEK 4

### PRAY FOR PROVISION FOR CHURCH PLANTERS AND THEIR FAMILIES

Church planting is hard work, but church planters don't earn much money for their efforts. As a result, they frequently struggle to afford essentials like food and clothing. Church planters and their families often live in poverty and depend on the generosity of others. *Pray that God would provide for the needs of church planters and their families so they can continue sharing the Gospel.*
