WEEK 1

PRAY FOR CHILDREN DISPLACED BY WAR

War often forces children to flee from their homes in search of safety. They're forced to leave behind their routine, friends, school, and belongings, and now, they're struggling to find a new normal without knowing if they'll ever be able to go home. *Please pray that God will provide these children with comfort and security in an unfamiliar place.*

WEEK 2

PRAY FOR CHILDREN WHO LACK ESSENTIALS BECAUSE OF WAR

In war-torn areas, children are going to bed hungry. War can cut off access to basic necessities like food, water, hygiene items, and healthcare. In some cases, store shelves are completely empty – and in others, these items are simply too expensive. *Pray that God will provide displaced children with the supplies they need to survive.*

WEEK 3

PRAY FOR CHILDREN ORPHANED BY WAR

During times of war, many children lose their parents to violent conflict. Being displaced is challenging regardless of circumstances, but children who lose their loved ones along with their homes are thrust into lives of instability and, oftentimes, extreme poverty. Without their parents and guardians, they're terrified and lost. *Pray God will help these grieving children cope with unimaginable loss and cover them with safety and love.*

WEEK 4

PRAY FOR CHILDREN SUFFERING FROM WAR-RELATED TRAUMA

Children who have lived through war have experienced unthinkable violence, destruction, and loss. No child should ever have to witness the horrors of war, and for many, this trauma will follow them into adulthood and hinders their development. *Please pray that these children heal from the pain that war has caused in their young lives and that God gives them peace that surpasses all understanding.*
