CYBERSECURITY TIPS AND TRICKS

When creating passwords, using uncommon characters or breaking up dictionary words can make passwords much harder to crack! An easy way to do both at once is to substitute a special character in place of a letter. Here's an example:

Original Password: BlueCar
Stronger Password: Blu#C@r

This also helps meet stronger password rules when they're required!
