TECH TIPS & TRICKS

Be careful when using AI, especially with World Help data. Even though some AI is regulated by privacy policies and federal laws, confidential data can still become public. That's because AI continually modifies its knowledge database based on the information it receives. If you need to use AI to process sensitive details, make sure to use the Copilot license associated with your World Help account!
